How to use Subversion

Hello!

Today I am going to teach you how to use Subversion (also referred to as SVN).

Subversion is an open source project and is used for version management, if you know what GIT is then this should be really simple.

Step 1.

First off we need a program to upload etc. there are several good programs to do this but the most common one is [Tortoise SVN](#). So basically we download the program from [here](#).

Step 2.

When you have installed Tortoise SVN we need a "repository", that's where we are going to store all files. You can of course host your own one but if you don't have the technical knowledge you can use [Google Code](#), they offer 2gb of space for free, it is enough if you will host profiles etc. (You can store over 1048576 profiles).

You need a Google account (You can use your YouTube, G+, Gmail etc. account) then click Create new project.

When creating you need to click subversion for as version control system.

Step 3.

Click on source tab in your projects site and follow onscreen instructions. Create a folder on your desktop, left click, click "checkout" use the address you saw in the source tab, click ok and then you can place all your profiles into the "trunk" folder. Then left click, click "add" then left click again and click "commit", write a message(Optional) and click ok.

Now you have a Subversion repository!
